

Articles of Incorporation of the

Ninja-IX Foundation

An Arizona Nonprofit Corporation

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Nonprofit Corporation, under the Laws of Arizona, do hereby certify:

1. The name of the Corporation shall be **Ninja-IX Foundation**.
2. Purpose: Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes.
3. Character of Affairs: The character of corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including:
 - a) Education Outreach, including training, to the internet operator community, both domestic and abroad.
 - b) Facilitate and / or operate Internet Exchange Points in order to facilitate the public benefit.
 - c) Any other legal purpose allowed by state or federal law.
4. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 2 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
5. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for

such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

6. The power of indemnification under the Arizona Revised Statutes shall not be denied or limited by the bylaws.

7. Board of Directors. The initial board of Directors shall consist of one director. The names and addresses of the person(s) who are to service as the directors until the first annual meeting of the Board of Directors, or until their successors are elected and qualified are:

All powers, duties and responsibilities of the incorporators shall cease at the time of the delivery of these Articles of Incorporation to the Arizona Corporation Commission.


11. Discrimination: The Corporation will not proacte or permit discriminationon the basis of sex, age, race, national origin, religion or physical handicap or disability.

12. MEMBERS: The corporation shall not have members.

13. Acceptance of Statutory Agent shall be on a form and manner approved by the Arizona Corporation Commission.

14. Certificate of Disclosure shall be on a form and manner approved by the Arizona Corporation Commission.
